Key knowledge to learn and remember

- ♣ Know that Queen Victoria ruled England during the Victorian Era (1837-1901).
- ♣ Know that there was a vast difference between how the poor and the rich lived.
- ♣ Know that Dr John Snow created a map to track the cholera outbreak to a pump on Broad Street.
- ♣ Know who Isambard Kingdom Brunel was and that some of his engineering creations are still used today e.g. Thames Tunnel is now the London Underground.
- ♣ Know that 'Railway Mania' had both positive and negative impacts on Britain but the network still stands today.
- ♣ Know that we continue to use Victorian methods of transport today (bikes, car, trains and trams) but in slightly different ways.
