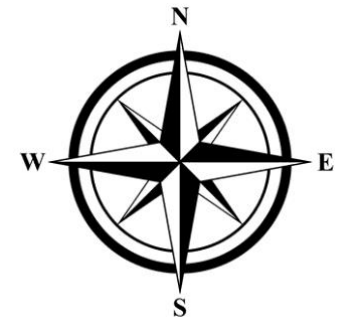
We know:

- ♣ Know that symbols are crucial on maps to create details that are necessary.
- ♣ Know that compass directions help to guide someone who is looking for a route.
- ♣ Understand that it is important to plan different routes in case something happens on one route making it unusable.
- ♣ Know that an atlas can be used to locate countries, counties, cities, rivers etc.
- ♣ Know how to use an atlas.
