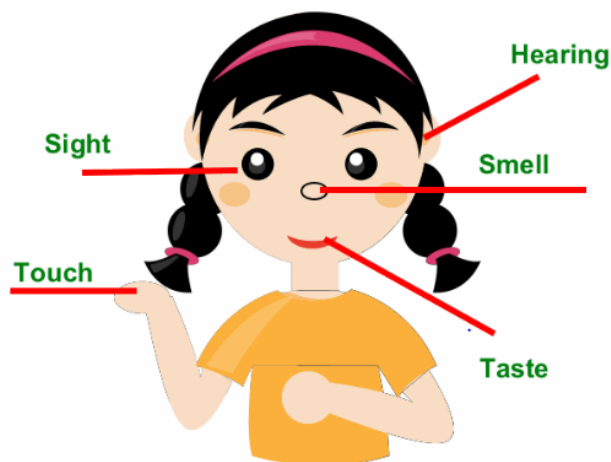

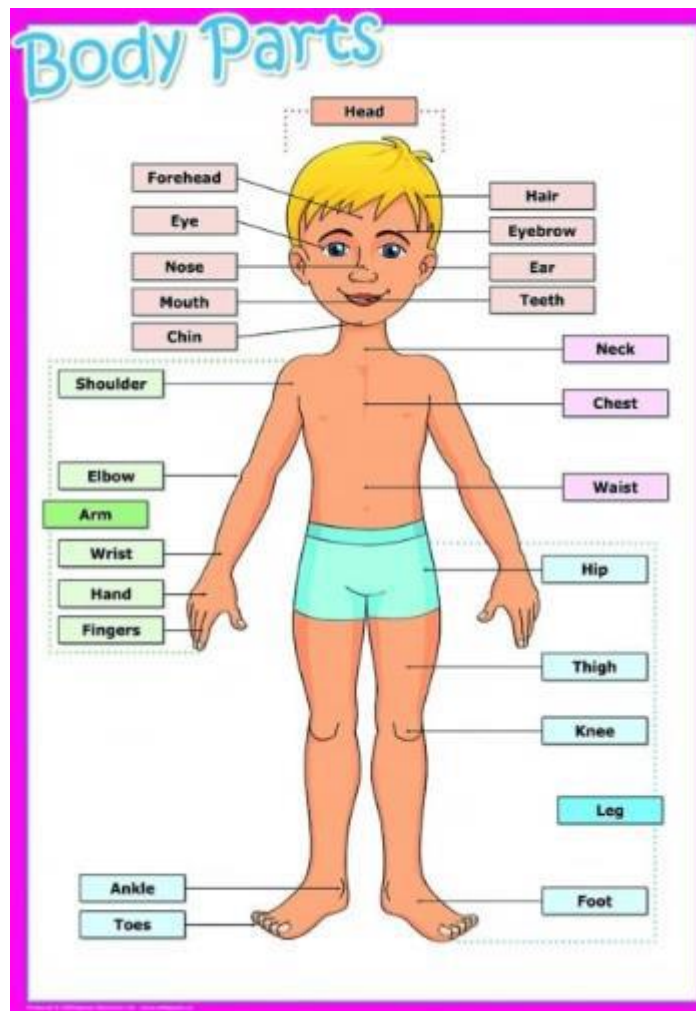
What facts do I need to know?

Key vocabulary

human – a person

sense – allows us to observe and understand the world around us.

sight – our eyes let us see what is around us

smell – we smell things using our nose

touch – we can feel things with the skin on our hands and other parts of our body

hear – we use our ears to hear sounds

taste – sense of flavour in the mouth

body part – a part of the body e.g. leg, knee

feature – description of the look of something or someone

observe – to watch

experiment – to investigate and find out
