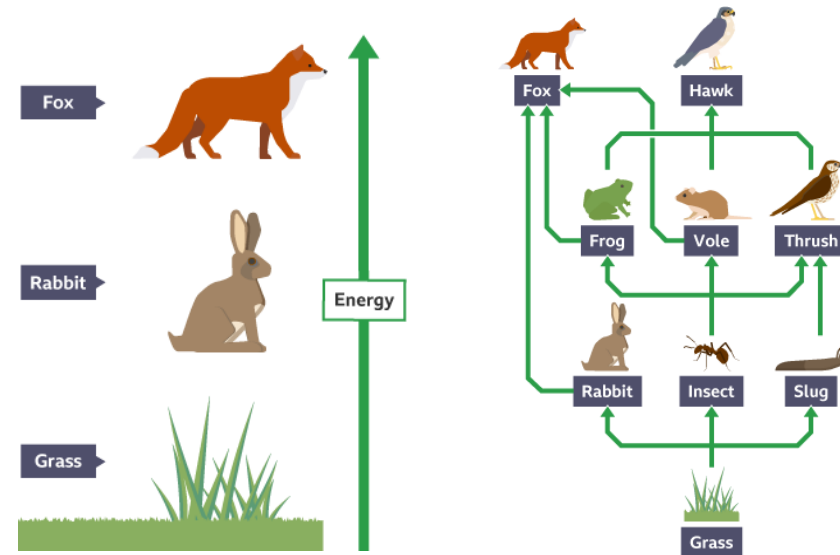
Prior Learning

- ♣ Children can identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- ♣ Children know animals have senses to explore the world around them and to help them survive.
- ♣ Children know that animals are alive; they move, feed, grow, use their senses and reproduce.

Key knowledge to learn and remember

- ♣ Carnivores eat meat.
- ♣ Herbivores eat plants.
- ♣ Omnivores eat both meat and plants.
- ♣ Animals can be found around the globe in a variety of habitats and have adapted their habitats and diets to survive.
- ♣ A food chain is a simple path from producer to consumer but a food web shows how food chains intertwine.
