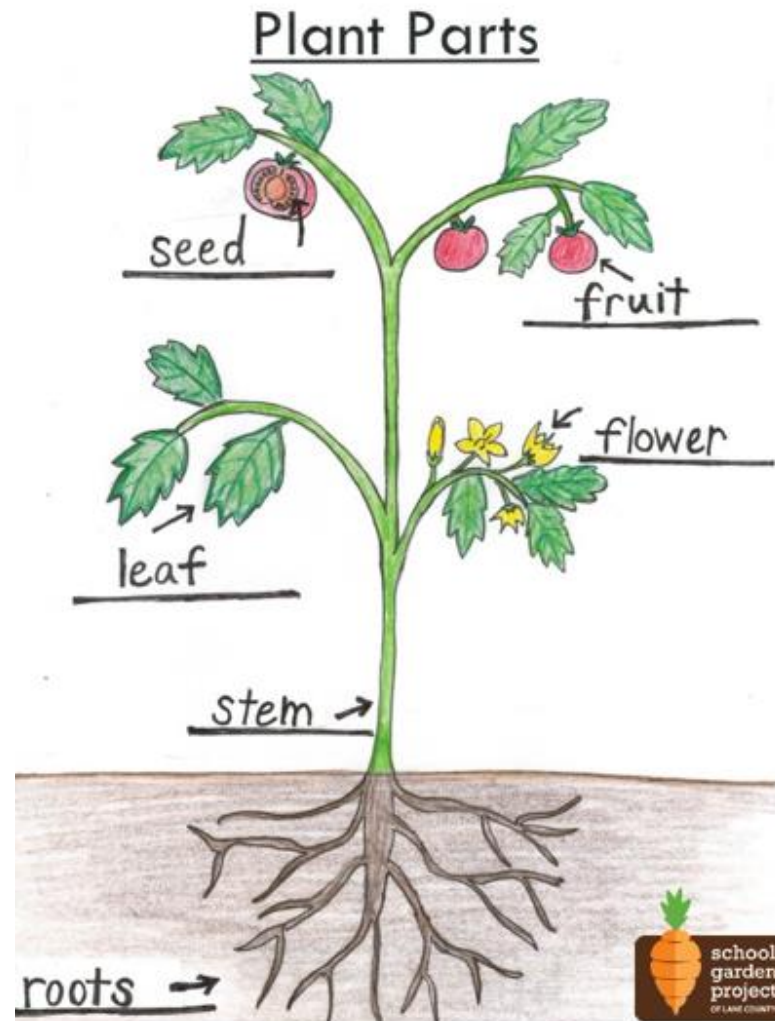


Parts of a plant	
roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.
stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and the flowers
leaves	Leaves catch the sunlight to make food
flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds
petals	Petals are the colourful part of the flower
fruit	Fruit contains the plant seeds.
seed	Seeds grow into new plants
bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants



Kinds of plants

evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its leaves or needles all year round, even in winter.
deciduous	A deciduous tree drops its leaves each year.
wild plants	A wild plant's seeds grow where they fall. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for, in order for it to grow.
garden plants	Garden plants are plants that people choose to put in their garden.
weed	Weeds are wild plants that grow often in places where people don't want them.
