How long have toys existed?	Toys have been around for thousands of years. The first toys were made from rock, stone and string.	<u>Victorian toys</u> – are toys that were played and made when Queen Victoria reigned <u>Modern toys</u> – toys that have been made recently
What are toys used for?	Toys are lots of fun! They allow you to use your imagination.	<u>Timeline</u> – an order of events placed on a line. <u>Chronological</u> – putting events in date order
What materials are toys made from?	Toys can be made from lots of materials like; paper, wood, metal, cotton, fabric. Most toys now are made from plastic.	<u>Toy</u> – object that we play with <u>Past</u> – having happened <u>Present</u> – existing now
How are modern toys different?	Modern toys tend to use electricity to work often using batteries. In Victorian days, children tended to play with wooden, handmade toys.	<u>Materials</u> – what something is made from <u>Old</u> – belonging in the past <u>Handmade</u> – made by someone <u>Factory made</u> – made in a factory <u>Compare</u> – to say what is different or similar
