Specialist PE coaches to model good PE skills across a range of team sports including football, hockey, basketball and cricket. Sports coach for dance and gymnastics	(£3440 per term)	Staff are gaining confidence in teaching exciting, structured PE lessons – catering for all ability levels and ensuring that pupils participate fully and enthusiastically in all aspects of PE. Teachers and TA's are identifying learning objectives to be covered by coaches to help develop CPD After school dance club provided for all year groups over the academic year. This led to school's participation in a community event to perform a dance supported by the dance coach
Year 4,5 & 6 extra swimming provision to develop style and stamina in swimming	£1040	All Year 6 children are able to swim 25m, demonstrate confidence in all 4 strokes and carry out a situation rescue. Swimming Gala- children won a silver and bronze award in the individual races and came second overall in the Division. The school now moves up into Division 5.
Life Education Bus	£386	Enhanced the children's PSHE curriculum with a clear focus upon Healthy Lives. Staff gain a further year's subscription to the planning tool.
Transportation to sporting competitions	£60	Children have opportunities to attend more sporting events as school does not have to rely too heavily

		on parents. Staff can now use the high school mini-bus.
Increase participation in competitive events inter-school sport with cluster and local schools.- School has run extra-curricular football and netball clubs in preparation for competitions.	£140	Football & Netball teams have now joined a league 2017-18. Participation in U11 Gymnastics competitions achieving individual silver medal and 4 th place overall for boys and 13 th place for girls Participation in Tag Rugby- awarded second place Participation in KS1 Football tournament for the first time.
Purchase of football kit	£444	Children now have a kit that is fit for purpose Juniors Purchased socks for KS1 Football team- now able to participate for the first time.
Purchase of new gymnasium equipment to enrich current provision	£692	Children able to practise ready for the competition in February 2018 Participation in U11 Gymnastics competitions achieving individual silver medal and 4 th place overall for boys and 13 th place for girls. Participation in U9's Gymnastic competition- achieved 16/22. One child achieved 6 th position overall in the individual competition.
Purchase of a Maypole	£420	Children were enabled to take part in a traditional dance at an afterschool. These children then represented the school at the local field day.

Maintenance of the MUGA to enable all round sports provision.	£900	Facility enables sports to be completed all year round. Expansion of line markings to incorporate 7 a-side-football.
Development of waste area into a school garden and pond environment	£548	All children have access to a wildlife area, broadening the provision of their learning experiences.
