

Three **different** numbers add up to 40

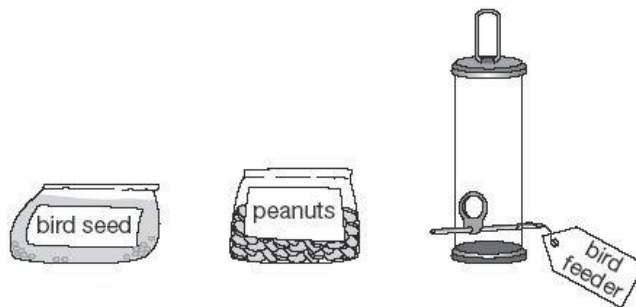
The numbers are all even.

Telford	166,640

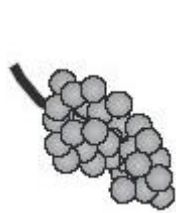
What is the **total** of the numbers of people living in Formby and in Telford?

What is the **difference** between the numbers of people living in Bedford and in Dover?

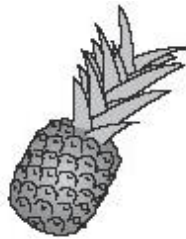
14,890 festival tickets were sold before the event.

How many people were at the festival altogether?

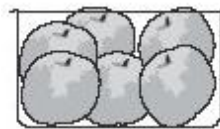
Amir and Lara buy some fruit.
