They have explored colour and recognise that colours can change. • Year One children have learnt the names of the features of faces and recognise different emotions. • Know that lines, dots and patterns are all forms of mark-making. • Know that Vincent Van Gogh and Pablo Picasso are famous artists • Know that a shadow is a dark shape created when light is blocked. • Know that tone can be light or dark. • Know that shadows are different tones of grey. • Know that hue is another word for colour. • Know the names and be able to recognise charcoal, chalk and oil pastel.			• Explore and record their own ideas through drawing, in response to first-hand observations, e.g. real objects and experiences. • Talk about their ideas and the choices they have made, e.g. chosen colours. • Describe what they think and feel about the work of a chosen artist. • Begin to talk about the style of a chosen artist. • Begin to use drawing techniques to explore the use of line, texture, colour and shape. • Begin to demonstrate control of given tools and materials to create a desired effect. • Talk about the features they like in their own work and in the work of others. • Talk about what they might change in their own work.
