Recounts (1-2)	Pluralise nouns using '-s' and '-es' e.g. dog, dogs; wish, wishes.	Use question marks
	Add the prefix 'un-' to verbs and adjectives to create 'opposite sentence.	Use capital letters for people, places and days of the week.
Poems to learn by heart	Orally plan and rehearse ideas.
