2 key features of grammar are evident in the clothes topic: A) Word order as adjectives generally come after the noun. B) Spelling of adjectives vary for gender and number.	Adjectives to describe the clothes, mainly colours although we will use big, small, and medium in French.	Silent b, d, p, t, s and x when it is the final letter. This occurs often in the pronunciation of clothes.
Key Learning		
- Pupils will memorise items of clothing in French and be able to recognise them visually and say the correct French. - Pupils will listen to various school pupils describe what they are wearing and understand what was said. - Pupils will read a quite detailed text of what someone is wearing and be able to say if it is true or false, using a photo. - Pupils will be able to write several sentences about what they wear (Je porte...).
