Adjectives such as intelligent, cool, charming, polite, happy, sad etc.	Pupils will revisit much of this vocabulary again when they cover the animal topic in Spring 2 2023/24. We will focus on 'il/elle est' again in addition to many adjectives which can be reused to describe the animals (colour, size and character).

- Il/elle est (varying the verb 'etre' from 'je suis'). - Masculine and feminine singular endings for the adjectives. - Plural endings for 'les yeux' and 'les cheveux'.	Adjectives such as intelligent, cool, charming, polite, happy, sad etc. Numbers 1-12.	- B, d, p, t, s and x - Adjectives with variable endings for masculine and feminine which cause pronunciation change. - Correct pronunciation of 'il/elle est'.
Key Learning		
- Listen carefully and copy and repeat sounds accordingly. - Speak initially in single words but build into correct descriptive sentences. - Work as a class together but also in pairs to act out short sentences.
